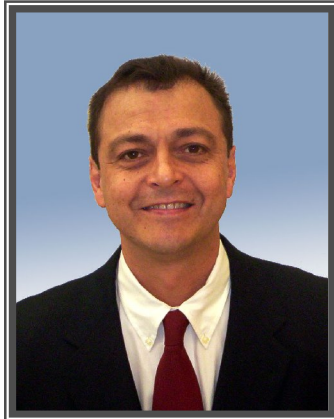

Tony Novaria specializes in high technology project management with 20 years experience in the high tech and aviation industries. Mr. Novaria's career includes positions as Systems Analyst, Field Service Operations Manager, Network Specialist and Senior Project Manager.

Tony is currently IT and Communications Director for Advanced Simulation Systems, Inc. (ASSI) based in Austin, Texas. ASSI is a U.S. defense prime contractor specializing in DoD, DoN special studies and analysis, centrifuge analysis plus aerospace simulation research and development. ASSI has an international client base and provides contract consulting to Rockwell Collins, Moog, Alion Science and Technology (formerly IITRI) and other defense contractors. The firm also provides designs, acquisition and program consulting services in the area of flight simulation and training. Defense industry analysts *Frost & Sullivan* named ASSI winner of the "2004 Technology Innovation Award - Aerospace and Defense Sector" for its development contributions to a breakthrough 360-degree motion simulator technology called *Cyberball*.

Prior to ASSI, Tony spent over 8 years with Dell Computer Corporation at their headquarters in Austin Texas. He joined Dell as a technician, was promoted to Senior Analyst then Project Manager designing lab infrastructures and managing their implementation for Dell's IT department. Tony was promoted to Technical Project Manager for the Advanced Technology Group. He served as chief architect of the Dell Technology Briefing Center, a state-of-the-art technology demonstration facility. Mr. Novaria researched, analyzed, and presented emerging technologies to senior Dell executives including Michael Dell.
